# Resolution

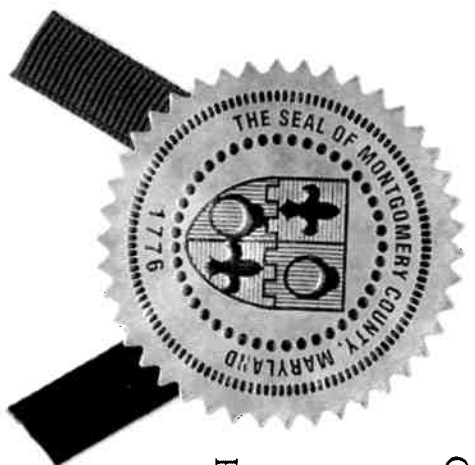
