Fred Chatterton has been involved in various aspects of Federal procurement for 28 years, all with the Civil Service Commission/Office of Personnel Management. Mr. Chatterton began his career in procurement as a purchasing agent/imprest fund cashier in 1975, was promoted to a contract specialist in 1977, became the Contract Branch chief in 1985 and ultimately became the Contracting Division Chief in 1989, a position he holds today.

Mr. Chatterton has an unlimited contracting officer warrant and management responsibility for the Office of Personnel Management procurement program nationwide. Mr. Chatterton has awarded multi-million dollar contracts for information technology hardware and services and business process improvement initiatives, successfully awarded one of the Federal Government's first employee stock owned corporations to handle Governmentwide background investigations, and has awarded contracts to establish training centers in Aurora, Colorado and Shepherdstown, West Virginia. Additionally, Mr. Chatterton has recently successfully completed two A-76 streamlined competitive sourcing competitions.
