

Project Prioritization
Partnership for Intergovernmental Management and Accountability
Adopted October 12, 2007

- 1. Developing joint strategies for reducing erroneous payments in state-administered programs.***
2. Determining how the single audit process can continue to meet its objectives.
3. Assisting with implementation of the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2006 by developing a common approach to collecting data at the state and local level.
4. Developing a model Memorandum of Understanding for sharing government data.
5. Identifying and publicizing internal controls that should be in place to improve accountability in disaster assistance programs.
6. Reducing the number of federal payment systems used by states for the draw down of federal funds.
- 7. Working to ensure that federal cost allocation policies are consistent across regions.***
8. Compiling and distributing information about intergovernmental pilot projects.
- 9. Issuing the first “Annual Intergovernmental Alert” identifying federal legislation, regulations or policy that will have an impact on state and local governments.***
10. Promoting the use of XBRL between the various levels of government.
11. Facilitating the development of purchasing consortia.

* Projects in bold are those agreed to by the Partnership’s Steering Committee on October 12, 2007. Additional projects will be approved as the initial projects are completed.
