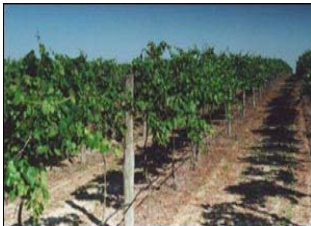
Monday, July 12, 2010

Florida's Wine Country

Enjoy a tour that showcases Florida's own wine making process at Lakeridge Winery and Vineyards. Lakeridge opened its doors in February 1989 in Clermont, Florida and sits on a 127-acre estate in gently rolling countryside some 25 miles west of downtown Orlando. After years of phenomenal growth, Lakeridge ranks as Florida's largest premium winery, and remains a pioneer in the development of table and sparkling wines from muscadine and hybrid grapes. Vintage-dated varietals from hybrids such as Stover and Blanc Du Bois are produced and marketed along with blended and sparkling wines from native

Muscadine grapes.

The tour begins upstairs in the theater to view a 12-minute video presentation featuring demonstrating the growing of the Florida grapes to the wine making process and the finishing with the bottling and labeling. Guests are then guided to a catwalk to view the production area and then outside to the balcony to see the spectacular view of the vineyards where the grapes are grown and harvested. Afterwards, browse the large retail area with gift shop featuring all the Lakeridge Wines, gourmet foods such as fine olive oils, a variety of salad dressings, assorted cheeses, crackers, gourmet mustards, salsas and hot sauces. There are many other gift items and wine accessories for the home wine enthusiast, as well as a variety of cook books and wine reference guides.

The Wonders of Winter Park

Developed in 1882 as a winter resort for wealthy northerners, Winter Park is now referred to by locals as “Little Europe”. The day begins with a private tour in the beautiful Morse Museum, where guest can view the world's most comprehensive collection of the works of Louis Comfort Tiffany. Including Tiffany jewelry, pottery, paintings, art glass, leaded-glass windows, lamps, and the chapel interior he designed for the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago.

After the Museum guests enjoy a perfect one-hour respite... the Scenic Boat Tour.

Along this 12-mile passage of spring-fed lakes and canals, guests see nature at its finest—Blue Herons, Ibises, towering cypress trees, sleeping hibiscus and on occasion, an alligator. Next, guests come ashore and take a stroll down Park Avenue. This tree-lined brick street is filled with sidewalk cafes, one-of-a-kind posh boutiques, and a smattering of “hip” and well-known shops. Winter Park is a destination that is sure to charm visitors of all ages.

AGA's visit to Orlando is not complete without a trip to Kennedy Space Center. Worlds apart from Orlando's theme parks, yet only just 45 minutes away from the Marriott, is NASA's launch headquarters – the only place on Earth where you can tour launch areas, meet an Astronaut, see giant rockets, and experience the new state of the art Shuttle Launch simulator Experience. Each year, millions of visitors make the trek to this hub of technology and discovery, where many of mankind's greatest accomplishments take place.

Begin the day with a narrated drive to Kennedy Space Center where guests experience an up close and personal look at the creativity and ingenuity that has gone into creating the most famous space program in the world. The tour begins with a short security clearance followed by a 2-hour guided tour of the Kennedy Space Center facility including massive launch pads, gigantic assembly building and the Apollo/Saturn V Visitor's Center. Following the tour, guests enjoy a lunch accompanied by a NASA Astronaut Corps member who mingles with the guests and answer any questions you may have about the space program. After lunch, guests are exposed to the fabulous 3-D IMAX attraction after which the tour concludes with free time to explore the Visitor's Complex, Rocket Garden and NASA Space Shuttle replicas.
