3. Describe how you supported current CGFMs this year (i.e., help fulfill CPE requirements, recognize CGFMs' achievements, provide networking opportunities for CGFMs). (worth 25 points) (3500 Character Limit)
4. Did your chapter obtain formal, tangible recognition of the CGFM by government agencies or other entities this year? If yes, please describe. (worth 10 points) (3500 Character Limit)
5. Did your chapter have members who earned the CGFM designation this year? If yes, how many? (worth 5 points) (3500 Character Limit)
