Selection criteria for the award will be generally limited to achievements accomplished in the preceding calendar year. The National Awards Committee will use the following criteria to evaluate and rank nominees. Therefore, for each key factor listed below, describe in specific terms, the work or contribution that justifies the nomination.

1. Describe your chapter's most memorable service event this year and how it has impacted your community. (25 points) (3500 Character Limit)
2. How did the project benefit your members/the chapter? (25 points) (3500 Character Limit)
3. Describe participation in the project (i.e., did it engage the majority of members, potential new members, diverse members, what percentage of members participated?). (worth 20 points) (3500 Character Limit)
4. Describe how AGA's visibility was increased by participating in the activity (i.e., was AGA promoted at the event; was AGA recognized for participating?). (worth 20 points) (3500 Character Limit)
5. Did your chapter do something new or innovative in community service this year that should be celebrated or sponsor a project related to the accounting/auditing professions? (worth 10 points) (3500 Character Limit)
