2. Individual's demonstration of leadership, advocacy, interest and initiative in improving government financial management matters (worth 30 points) (750 Word Limit)
3. Results of individual's outstanding government service (savings, increased productivity, service improvements) (worth 30 points) (750 Word Character Limit)

### **AWARD OVERVIEW**

- Honors elected or presidentially-appointed federal officials who exemplify and promote excellence in government management and have demonstrated exceptional leadership in enhancing sound financial management legislation, regulations, practices, policies and systems.
- Recognizes individuals in either the legislative or executive branch who have made outstanding contributions to enhancing government financial management.
- Nominees must have served in an elected federal position (e.g., Senator or Representative), or as a Presidential appointee at the time the contribution being recognized was made.
- Nominees do not have to be members of AGA.
- A maximum of two crystal awards presented.
