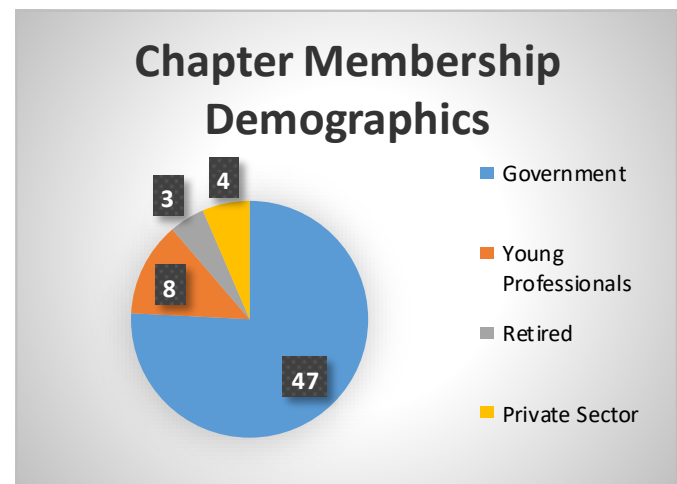

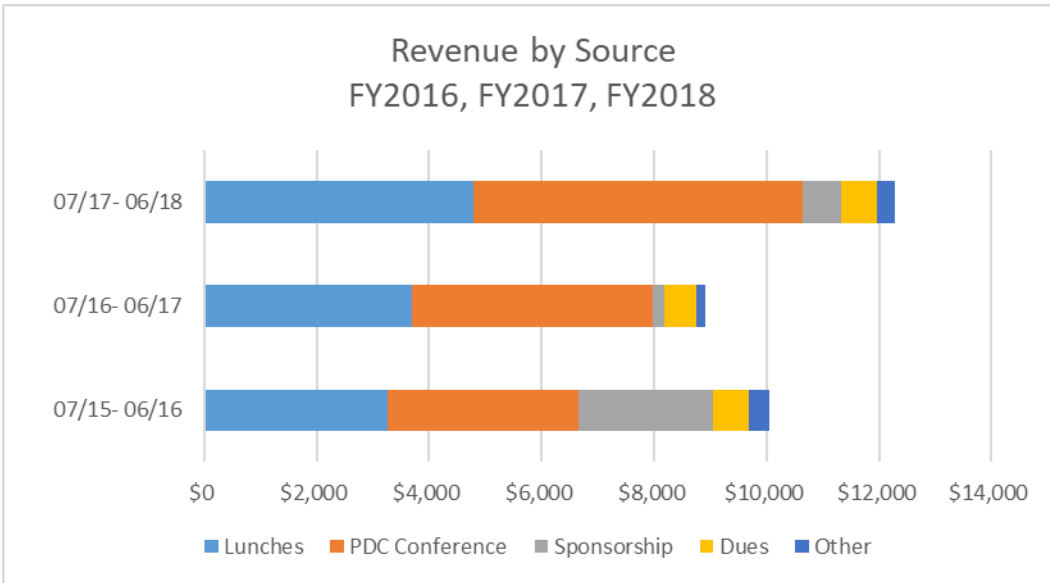

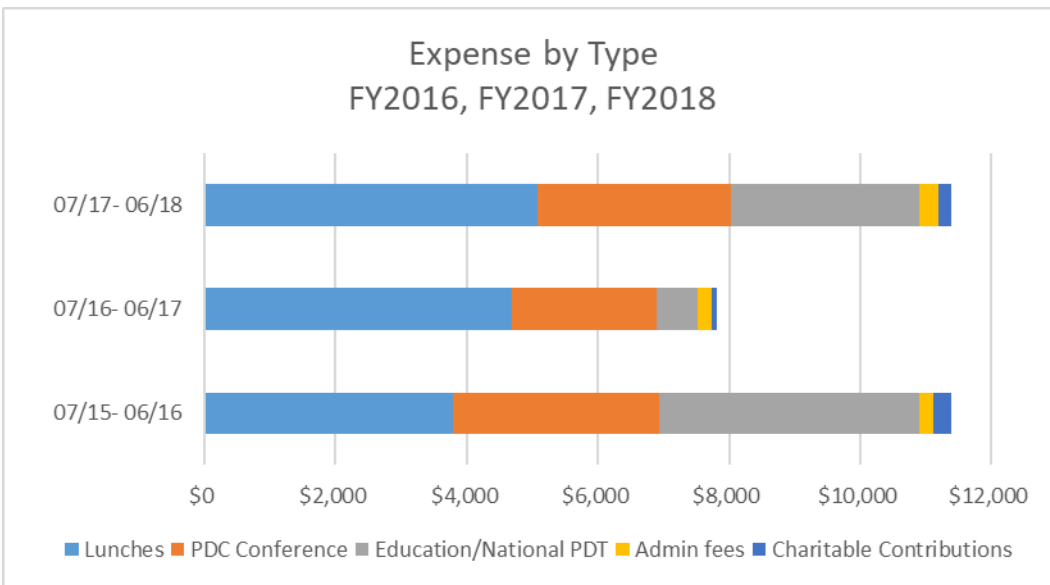
Community Events:
