The facility was very nice and the staff at Quest did an excellent job. We had 165 registered for our first all in person conference since 2019. We are very thankful for all who attended and hope you enjoyed the conference and will return again next year. We had one of our largest turn-outs for our Happy Hour at 101 Beer Kitchen in Westerville after the first day. We hope you enjoyed the Happy Hour and visiting with your peers. We hope our food options satisfied everyone's needs throughout the conference. Many thanks to our Education Committee members and Cognificent Learning who assisted with planning the conference throughout the year and all who volunteered as monitors for sessions and provided other assistance during the conference.
