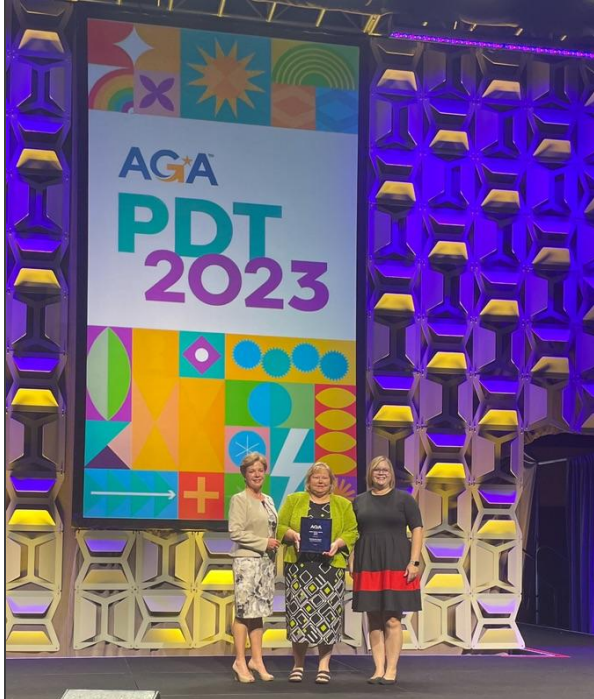
PDT Recap

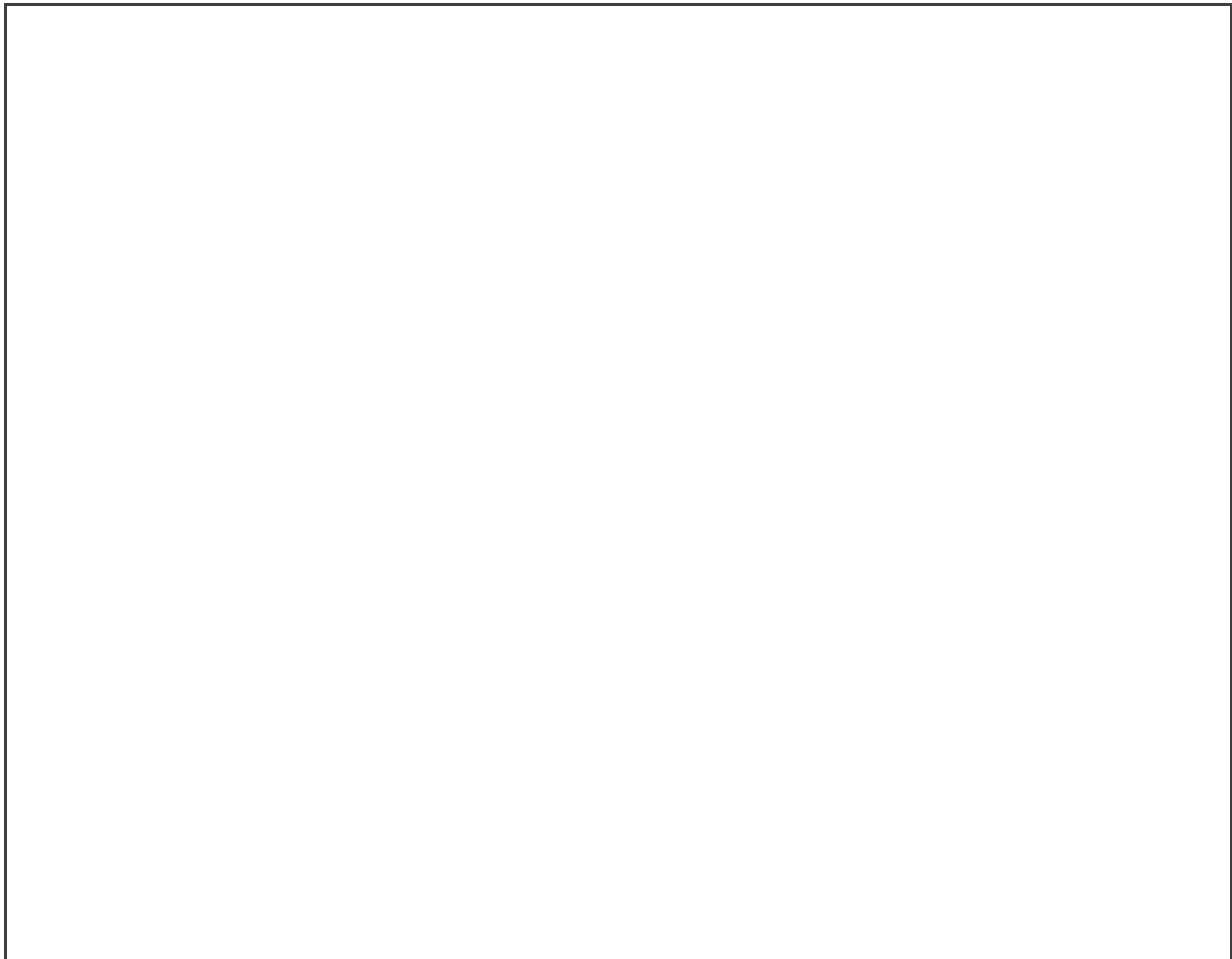
