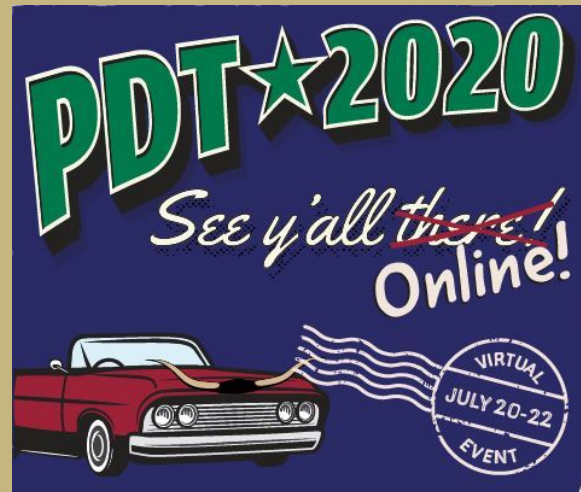


President's Letter Continued...
