

- 3. Receive one voucher code via email.
- 4. <u>Schedule and take your next CGFM exam using the voucher code as payment by July 31, 2025.</u>
- <u>Terms and conditions: To qualify for this promotion, an individual must take a</u> <u>CGFM examination between March 1 and April 30, 2025.</u>
- <u>Tests taken prior to March 1, 2025 or after April 30, 2025 will not qualify for this promotion.</u>
- <u>We recommend requesting your voucher code as soon as you take the exam</u> <u>during the March-April 2025 timeframe.</u>
- <u>Voucher codes will only be distributed to those who request them and qualify</u> <u>for the promotion.</u>
- <u>Vouchers are non-transferable and a candidate may not receive more than one voucher.</u>
- All voucher codes will expire on July 31, 2025 and will not be extended for any reason. Testing appointments may fill up – candidates are encouraged to request their voucher code and schedule their appointment as soon as possible.
- Voucher codes will be distributed on specific dates only: 3/17, 3/31, 4/14, 4/28, and 5/7.
