CGFM Plan

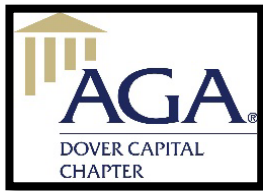

ADOPT A HIGHWAY

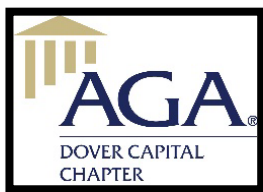


On May 25th, chapter members participated in the Adopt-a-Highway event in honor of Mequoria's brother Warner Jr.

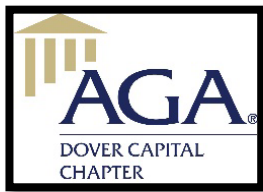
New 2019 National and Chapter President
