

The Center for Local Government Excellence (CLGE) will host its upcoming workshop on Wednesday, October 23, and Thursday, October 24, 2024. The workshop will take place in person at the Louisiana Immersive Technologies Enterprise (LITE) on the University of Louisiana at Lafayette (ULL) campus, with an option for live-stream participation. This complimentary, high-quality educational training will cover current issues relevant to Louisiana's local governments and non-profit organizations. A key focus for this workshop will be the pressing infrastructure maintenance and management challenges faced by water and sewer systems. Experts from the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), Louisiana Infrastructure Technical Assistance Corporation (LITACorp), Louisiana Rural Water Association (LRWA), and the Louisiana Legislative Auditor (LLA) will lead Thursday's sessions, offering insights and answering questions on water system management. On Wednesday, LLA instructors will cover updates to Louisiana laws for 2024, take a scenario-based approach to the Public Bid Law, and delve into public banking and investing. An auditor and a city mayor will also join the discussion on statewide agreedupon procedures, providing practical solutions to overcoming exceptions.
