Nathan Abbott, CFE, CISA, EA is an information systems audit manager for the Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury, Division of Local Government Audit. The division has statutory responsibility for audits of local governments in Tennessee.

A 21-year veteran of the office, Nathan has served as an information systems auditor, audit manager, and training instructor. In his current role as information systems manager, he is responsible for providing technical support and data analytics to the audit staff. Nathan teaches inhouse classes to the Tennessee Department of Audit and periodically makes presentations to several other professional organizations speaking on topics such as computer forensics and computer applications. He served on the National State Auditors Association External Peer Review program as a team member and is currently serving on the Peer Review Committee.

Nathan received his accounting degree from Freed Hardeman University. He is a Certified Information Systems Auditor, Certified Fraud Examiner, and Enrolled Agent with the IRS. Nathan is a member of the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) where he currently serves as co-webmaster for the Nashville Chapter. He has previously served as secretary, education chair and two-year director of the executive committee of AGA's Nashville Chapter. Nathan is also a member of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners where he previously served as president of the Middle Tennessee Chapter.
