


Inside Story...Journal CPE Online

Did you know that you can earn 3 CPE via online quizzes through the AGA National *Journal of Government Financial Management* publication? For those who don't currently receive a printed or electronic version of the *Journal*, you can contact Corrine A. Louden, *Journal* Editorial Board member, at corrine.louden@vadoc.virginia.gov.

Here are the steps to make sure you earning your required amount of CPE:

- Purchase one quiz for \$30 or a subscription of four quizzes for \$109.
- Read the *Journal*, which is published quarterly, planning on approximately three hours.
- Register and log on via the National AGA website (www.agacgfm.org/Training-and-Events)
- Take the 25-question quiz and receive 3 CPE for a score of 80% or higher.
