CHAPTER RECOGNITION PROGRAM

The Chapter Recognition Program is a guide to help chapters know what is expected of them and allows us to track our progress in completing tasks. Our goal for the year is 10,000 credits and we are currently at 8,025 credits. We can earn credits in 9 categories: Leadership, Education, CGFM, Communications, Membership, Accountability, Community, Awards, and Sponsorships. Credits are earned by completing tasks such as:

Leadership: filing with the IRS 500 credits, submitting plans for each category to National 200 credits for each plan.

Education: Webinars and training events 150 credits per CPE hour, marketing events to leaders, members, and non-members 50 credits per event.

CGFM: Provide courses that meet CPE requirements 50 per CPE hour, use the CGFM logo in promotions 50 per event, Sponsor a study group 200 credits.

Communications: Newsletter 100 credits, social networking site 100 credits, communication with National 25 per contact.

Membership: Welcome letters 100 credits per month, Attend local college events 200 credits.

Accountability: Prepare a Citizen Centric Report 350 credits, post Chapter CCR to website 50 credits, Prepare a CCR for a government agency 500 credits.

Community: host or participate in non-technical event 200 credits, host chapter fundraiser 200 per event.

These are just some of the things our Chapter has completed this year.
