


AGA Dover Capital Chapter Report 2018-2019



The Dover Capital Chapter officially began on May 10, 2002. We are a small chapter of approximately 50 members and growing. In 2018-2019 we had the highest Membership growth out of about 100 AGA chapters nationwide at 19%. The previous year we were down to about 34 members at our lowest point. Our focus is on bringing value to our members through educational events that offer CPE's. We are trying to expand our educational opportunities and also provide networking and communications for our members. Our greatest revenue source is our yearly Professional Development Training (PDT) that funds other educational events. Our greatest expenses are Webinars provided free of charge for our members throughout the year and the meals provided at our PDT. With additional revenues gained last year, we are providing more webinars in the 2019-2020 program year.




What subjects are you interested in learning about?
