Lincoln Chapter Meeting Minutes – February 5, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Ken Rouch filling in for President Ann Martinez. The meeting was held at Tico's, 317 S. 17th St, Lincoln, NE.

Ken first asked if any guests or new members were attending. Teresa Zulauf, Controller for Nebraska Public Employee Retirement Systems, was a guest of Tim Baker. Marisue Wagner, Grants Manager with Nebraska Department of Transportation, attended as a guest of Ken's.

Ken then asked Jessica Elliott, Director of Community Service, to report on upcoming events. Jessica reported on the Junior Achievement annual fundraising Bowl-a-thon. AGA members are encouraged to help with the cashiering function. This will be conducted at Hollywood Bowl, Parkway Lanes, and Sun Valley Lanes on February 21-22.

Ken announced that recruiting for the 2020-2021 Chapter Executive Committee (CEC, governing board) is now under way. The slate needs to be approved at the March CEC meeting then proposed at the April Chapter meeting for a vote of Chapter membership.

Ken announced the March meeting will be held at Miller Time Pub, The Cornhusker. The speaker will be Paul Koehler. His topic will be his work involving Government/Non Profit/Auditing consulting.

Ken then introduced the speaker for the day. The speaker was Frank Faughn. Frank is a long-time AGA member, twice past Chapter President, and past Regional Vice President. Frank spoke about updates on income tax rules and regulations. The discussion was lively with numerous questions.

There was no raffle since the Secretary forgot the raffle tickets.

Lincoln Chapter CEC Meeting Minutes – February 26, 2020

Our President, Ann Martinez, opened the meeting at 12:05. A quorum was present.

Discussion started on the LEAD meeting. This LEAD meeting replaces what used to be the Section Leadership Meeting (SLM) held in two locations. The LEAD will be for the whole of AGA and serve as training for chapter representatives. Lincoln Chapter's representative on the NCC (National Council of Chapters) is Tim Baker. He will attend this LEAD meeting. Frank Faughn also volunteered to attend. One other slot is open. This meeting will be held April 30 6:00pm through May 2 at noon in Dallas.

Discussion followed on the slate of officers for 2020-2021. A few current members will not continue. Vacancies include: PDT director, two co-directors for meetings, and director of

Professional Certification. Members are encouraged to join the CEC. The other existing officers will continue in their current officers, with these exceptions. Ann will serve again as President. In addition to serving as Director of Membership and Young Professionals Frank will serve as President-elect next year.

The national PDT will be in Dallas July 19-23. The chapter NCC member, Tim Baker, will attend. The motion was made by Frank, seconded by Ron, to send Ann, which motion passed.

For Education, the Chapter will host a webinar on Cybersecurity. This will be March 25, 1:00 to 2:50, in the 1526 Bldg training room. The spring chapter PDT will be May 14th at Innovation Campus. Speakers are yet to be determined.

The next chapter meeting will be March 4, featuring Paul Koehler. He will discuss his work as a consultant and trainer concerning Governmental Accounting, Auditing, and Non-Profits. This will be held at the Miller Time Pub, The Cornhusker, starting at 11:45. The April meeting will be held on <u>Thursday</u> April 2, because the 1st of the month is always hectic for accountants. The speaker will be Josh Overocker, Associate Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs. The site is yet to be determined.

Regarding Membership and Young Professionals discussion followed about the event held earlier in February, Meet the Firms. Ann, Frank, and Jeff attended. It was pretty much the same as in prior years, but with fewer businesses involved.

There was no report on Accountability & Outreach. For Communications, Channer mentioned articles for the newsletter can be sent to him by February 28.

Regarding Professional Certification, CGFM Month of March quickly approaches. The State and City Proclamations will be made. However, no chapter members volunteered to participate in any ceremony so these will be signed and mailed.

For Community Service, discussion followed regarding the Junior Achievement Bowl-a-thon with which some AGA members helped. Some CEC members present participated. It was mentioned that when AGA members were not available to help then JA Board members filled in.

Baker reported that sponsorships are coming in robustly. The Lincoln Chapter has received three checks from sponsors with a fourth already negotiated. Congratulations Tim! Tim also reported on NCC activities. First, being considered is a name change for AGA. This would recognize that many AGA members are not accountants or auditors. Next, the contract for national AGA CEO, Ann Ebberts, has been extended four years. Finally, the Chapter Recognition Program (CRP) is undergoing changes to be effective next year.

The Treasurer's Report was distributed by Ann in the absence of Dan. The motion was made by Channer, seconded by Frank, that the report be approved, which passed.

Ken reported that the January Chapter and CEC minutes had been published in the January newsletter and asked if there were any needed changes. Hearing none, Ron Carlson made the motion, which Baker seconded, that the minutes be approved as published. The motion passed.

With no further business the meeting was adjourned.
