The goal of this scholarship program is to encourage students to graduate with a Bachelor's or a Master's degree in Accounting, Financial Management or Public Administration and to promote the pursuit of public financial management careers.

Eligibility:

All candidates must be at least a sophomore at the beginning of the semester for which the scholarship applies at either a community college or university, be enrolled in an Accounting, Finance or Public Administration curriculum, and must be considering a career in governmental financial management.

Due Date:

The scholarship deadline is February 28, 2022.

Requirements:

Candidates should complete the application and submit a copy of his/her transcript (unofficial copy is fine) along with a brief essay (no more than one page double spaced). The essay should answer the question:

Why did you decide to pursue government finance and how will you make a difference in the world through your career?
