Employee will be assigned to the Business Operations Office, Fiscal Services and will perform expert level accounting, auditing and reporting duties under limited supervision. Duties include:

• Lead accountant/auditor of the budget section, training, guiding and approving work of accounting staff.

- Preparing agency federal drawdowns and serve as point of contact for federal agencies.
- Preparation of the department's expenditure schedule and appropriation request for assigned division and to assist with other division budgets.
- Evaluate efficiency and effectiveness of assigned division, analyzing financial records for completeness and accuracy to determine compliance with state and federal laws. Prepares correcting documents as necessary.
- Serve as backup for the daily investment of the department's interest-bearing funds.
- Conduct desk reviews of independent audits of various sub-grantees, compile data for cost sharing departmental reports.
- Use WVOASIS accounting system and crystal reports software for financial analysis and projections.
- Employee will perform other duties as required and/or assigned.
