## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2022-2023

THE CHATTANOOGA CHAPTER OF THE ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTANTS offers two scholarships to students who have completed 60 hours in their field by fall 2022. The association's goal is to promote information and interest in a governmental career. Both undergraduate and graduate students are encouraged to apply if they meet the eligibility requirements. The scholarship provides \$500 to the school of the recipient toward the recipient's tuition.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Attending a regional college or university and in good standing
- Must join AGA as a student member, free of charge
- Attending college during the current school year
- Must have ONE personal or professional letter of recommendation

The scholarship is awarded based on a combination of four criteria described in the required essay. The award is based on an equal 25% allocated to the **essay's composition, civic involvement, financial need, and academic achievement**. The essay must be less than 750 words. It should provide information regarding the following:

- Why are you considering a governmental career
- Discuss career objectives and leadership abilities
- Describe why you feel you deserve the award
- Describe your civic involvement
- Describe your financial need, including any disparity or circumstances that you think should be considered when evaluating your application

Please fill out the application below and attach the **required** information: application, essay, letter of recommendation, and transcript. Any supporting documents (resume etc.) should also be attached. The material should be sent to the Scholarship Committee Chair on or before **March 31, 2023**.
