## Our Finances

### *Revenues and Expenditures*

### **Revenues by Source**



Our PY 2021 Government Professional Accounting Webinar was a 1 (vs. 2-day) event with lower pricing than in-person PY 2020 training. Our PY 2020 Government Professional Accounting Seminar was a 2 (vs. 1-day) event with greater attendance than in the prior year.

Other revenues primarily related to miscellaneous income.

### **Expenses by Type**



There were no seminar expenses for the PY 2021 GPAW. The PY 2020 training was a live 2-day event incurring normal event expenses. Other expenses include D&O insurance premiums of approximately \$1,600 in both PYs 2021 and 2020.

Our PY 2020 Expenses for the Government Professional Accounting Seminar increased as the training was 2 (vs. 1) days and greater attendance consistent with the increase in revenue.

The figures presented above are unaudited figures covering July through June for fiscal years 2019, 2020 and 2021. The Chapter executive committee reviewed the financial reports, however the tax return, Form 990, has been independently reviewed.
