Michael Bingham, U.S. Government Accountability Office

Mr. Bingham is a Senior Auditor for the Financial Management and Assurance (FMA) team at the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO). He is part of the Standards group, and his duties have included the 2018 revision of Government Auditing Standards (the Yellow Book), developing a training course on internal control for performance audits, and responding to Yellow Book and Green Book technical assistance inquiries.

Mr. Bingham is also a member of multiple AICPA task forces and working groups and serves as a project liaison to the International Organization of Supreme Audit Institutions (INTOSAI). Mr. Bingham has worked on financial and performance audits of various U.S. Government entities, focusing primarily on government-wide and Department of Defense financial management matters. Prior to joining GAO, Mr. Bingham worked for an inner city tutoring and mentoring non-profit in Chicago.

Mr. Bingham received his B.A. in Political Science from the University of Chicago and his M.A.S. from Northern Illinois University. Mr. Bingham is a CPA licensed in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
