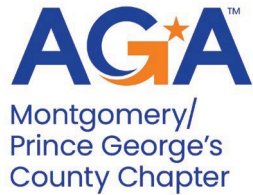
1. **Title: AI Savvy: Generative Artificial Intelligence (GenAI)**

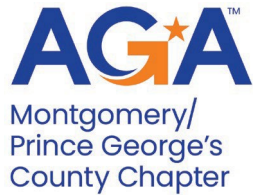
1. **Title: FASAB Update**

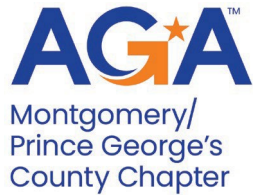
1. **Title: The Financial Report of the U.S. Government – An Update**

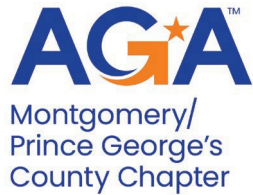
1. **Title: Using the Social Style® Framework to be a Better Leader**
