


# CU Supply Chain Management



## PURCHASING

- 14 employees
- Primarily centralized structure
- Responsible for procurement of goods, materials, and services (including construction)
- FY23 Purchasing Spend = \$171,729,890.82



# CU Supply Chain Management



## INVENTORY CONTROL

- 22 employees
- 5 primary storage locations & 5 satellite locations
- ~ \$35,000,000 in active inventory
- > 23,000 SKU currently in stock
