

2023-2024 AGA VA Peninsula Chapter Survey Summary

General Questions:

1. For the upcoming 2024-2025 AGA program year (September 2024 – June 2025), should we continue having our monthly Chapter meetings in a virtual environment, or return to in-person meetings?

Virtual: 12 (100%)

In-person: 0 (0%)

Feedback: Continue meetings in a virtual environment due to work demands and most working remotely.

2. Should the Fall PDT (traditionally held at the Great Wolf Lodge in December) be held virtually or in-person this year?

Virtual: 4 (33.33%)

In-person 8 (66.7%)

Feedback: This is a good opportunity for all members to get together in-person; I'd like to see us move away from offering virtual if we can't reduce the cost of AV expenses; determine if both options are a possibility.
