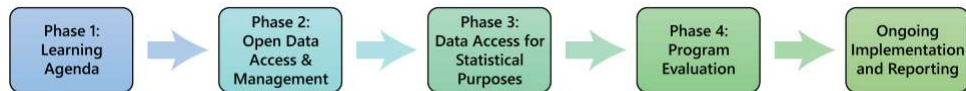

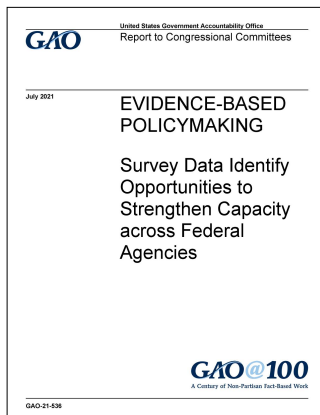

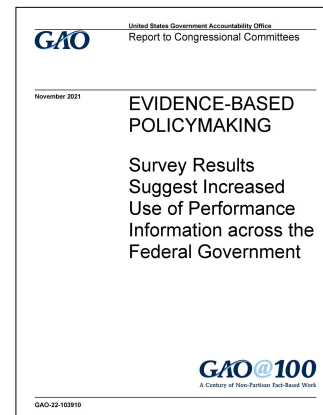
GAO's Findings from 2020 FMS Results

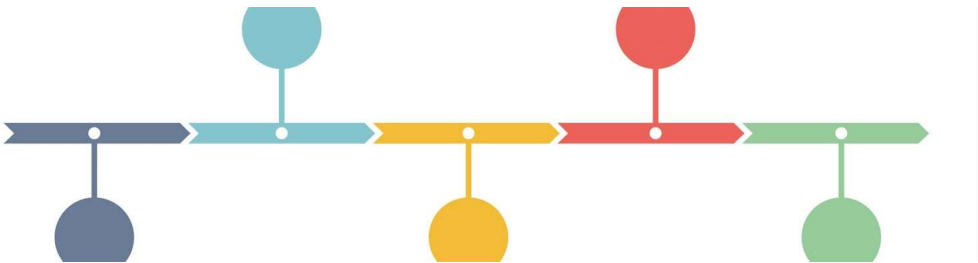
