

Introducing **Team Battle**, a fun quiz-style game that can be played in real-time with teams of attendees from your audience.

How Team Battle Works

- The battle moderator creates teams that will participate in the battle
- The moderator creates quiz questions and defines how many points each question is worth (e.g., 5 points for 1st place, 3 points for 2nd place, and 1 point for 3rd place).
- Attendees join the game and pick their team
- The moderator launches each quiz question and attendees respond
- The winner of each round is determined by the percentage of team members who answered correctly. If there is a tie, the average response time per team is used as a tie breaker
- A leaderboard can be projected on stage and it will update each team's score after each round
