Session ideas brainstorming:

- NLT 2025 will attract more college students due to the addition of the Datathon plus the National Collegiate Leadership Program, consider sessions that will address the needs of students and how to keep them attracted and engaged with public service work.
- Difference between management and leadership - Leadership is more important than management. AI can take care of the 'output' or the management side, but we need to lead in order to make sure that output is effective and impactful.
- Change management topics especially with the new administration next year.
- AI in the workplace - Skillset you're going to need 10 years from now is going to be different than the skillset that you need now. Leverage AI now.
- Soft skills – Soft skills and how to work with people are the skills needed for the future, AI and RPA can take care of the technical stuff, but AI cannot handle workforce relationship and development.
- Invite CFO council to present some of the things that they're working on and present the new tools they are developing for the community.
- Strategic plans - designing better agency strategic plans so that agencies are better prepared to manage the non-financial risks and objectives.
- Measuring key performance indicators - using data-driven analysis to manage risks.
- Incorporating technology to ERM programs – adding unstructured data to build risk models on financial data.
- Topics on Future Leadership and Upskilling in Government – promoting people solely on technical skills is not enough, its more important for people to have leadership and people skills in order to be effective in their jobs.
- Fostering creativity in government – what worked many years ago may not work today.
