The CFO organization is the principal advisor to the IRS Commissioner and Deputy Commissioners on all financial management programs and reporting, and serves as the principal liaison with IRS executives, Treasury, OMB and congressional committees on matters related to IRS budget administration.

Bryan previously served as the Associate CFO for Corporate Budget, where he served as a consultant and advisor to the CFO on all aspects of budget policy, formulation and strategic planning, investment analysis, governance, and performance strategies. Bryan has over 30 years of experience managing various financial plans across the IRS, including IT, Appeals, Tax Exempt/Government Entities, and the Chief Operating Officer. He started his career as an economist in the IRS Research Division in 1984.
