NOMINATION QUESTIONS:

The National Awards Committee will use the following criteria to evaluate and rank nominees. Therefore, for each key factor listed below, describe in specific terms, the work or contribution that justifies the nomination. It is especially important to write a description under each key factor 1 through 3 listed below.

1. Significant contribution to excellence in diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility in government financial management, specifically addressing awareness, education, advocacy and overall commitment to the responsibility of being a diverse, equitable, inclusive, and accessible organization. (worth 40 points) (750 Word Limit)
2. Individual's demonstration of leadership, advocacy, interest, and initiative in improving and promoting awareness, education, and overall commitment to inclusivity and the careers and advancement of all, regardless of gender, race, age, sexuality, disability, education, or class. (worth 30 points) (750 Word Limit)
3. Results of individual's contributions to D, E, I & A initiatives within public sector organizations with respect to recruiting, promoting, retention, job satisfaction and morale, workplace flexibilities, research, best practices, etc. (worth 30 points) (750 Word Limit)

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF NOMINEE:

List the nominee's education and any other pertinent background information that will assist in evaluating the nominee's achievements. (500 Word Limit)

CITATION:

For use as the formal award citation, succinctly (using 2-3 sentences) describe the highlights of the accomplishments, particularly impact and results. (250 Word Limit)

AWARD OVERVIEW

- Recognizes demonstrated excellence and results in promoting diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility in their organization and/or has made a significant impact across a greater public sector population.
- Open to current and former employees in federal, state, local, and tribal governments and academia and is intended to recognize premier leadership efforts in D, E, I & A.
- Nominees must have been employed in government service at the time the work being recognized was performed.
- Nominees do not have to be members of AGA.
- One crystal award is presented.
