We will continue to invest in the Finance Committee, to improve operations for posterity; modernizing and automating chapter financial operations, where possible, to further enhance our efficiency and effectiveness and allow chapter administration to focus on serving members.

We will also continue advancing our Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Accessibility initiative and supporting said Committee. Chapter leadership is committed to fostering broad inclusion within our chapter and has created a welcoming and inclusive environment for all members. For example, all our chapter events are handicap accessible and we will make special allowance for members, as needed.
